Mycology is not an area in which the wildlife recorders are particularly knowledgeable, but armed with field guides, we have been able to identify the following species. Hopefully the list will expand in line with the knowledge of the recorders !.

The autumn of 2016 was a relatively poor one for fungi and no new species were recorded. Three new species were identified on the site in 2013, bringing the total number of species recorded to twenty six. With a visit to the Headstocks Nature Reserve planned by the Nottinghamshire Fungi Society in 2017, hopefully the number of species recorded will increase dramatically !.
